Which way to maximum protection?

Clear direction is crucial to a profitable centre, but when it comes to entranceways, the direction of the footfall can create its own problems. It's well known that entrance matting can play an important role in the efficient running of a busy centre by reducing cleaning expenditure, extending the life of flooring and helping to reduce the risk of slip accidents, but when you have a non-standard or multi-directional traffic flow, finding the right matting solution is even more important to ensure that such all-important protection is offered.

Directionality of footfall was the issue faced by Tony Parrott, Centre Manager for Bracknell Regeneration Partnership at Princess Square Shopping Centre, Bracknell, "Traffic entering the Pavilion entrance, makes an immediate 90 degree left turn on the entrance matting, so customers were walking both across and along the lengths of the previous matting installation, which wasn't ideal for maximum moisture or dirt removal."

"Therefore, when it came to the refurbishment of this entranceway, we had a combination of criteria that needed to be met — we needed a smart, aesthetically pleasing solution that would work with the non-standard directionality of the traffic flow, plus matting that could be easily cleaned by our team and of course was cost effective."



achieved using a diagonal T-bar allowing the Obex Forma tiles to be laid at 90 degrees to each other. The Milliken Obex Forma matting consists of a PVC tile with high twist nylon fabric inserts for maximum moisture removal. With each tile measuring 19.5cm square, this enables such an installation to be created with minimal wastage and offers the customer the advantage that in the future, if required, small areas can easily be replaced at minimal cost.

This meant that visitors entering through one set of doors were walking
