system will ensure that in the

event of a fire damage to the stock, plant and machinery is minimised. The stone wool insulation compartmentalises the building, preventing the spread of smoke and flames. Containing the fire in a vast building where a substantial number of people are

The firemaster panel has guaranteed an efficient and safe means of escape for all employees in the event of a fire. The core will not burn when exposed to heat or flames so damage from smoke is minimal.

Firemaster offers up to four hours fire resistance dependant of individual specification and has been tested and approved to a wide range of UK safety standards such as LPS 1181, 1208 along with Factory Mutual 4880 and BS476 Part 22.

to develop an internal wall system that is not only hygienic and fire safe but has exceptional environmental credentials also. Both the steel and stone wool core can be fully recycled at the end of their useful life, allowing Eurobond to employ recycled materials back into the manufacturing process, presenting customer with a sustainable, low risk building solution.
