New production line comes on stream

Kingspan's new £1.25m production line has now come on stream - at the same time as we are experiencing a major increase in demand for our panels!

During recent months we have more than doubled sales compared to last year, and October was our busiest month for the past three years for international sales.

We are also confident that 2014 wll be a very successful year for Kingspan – we have already seen a 9.5% increase in our estimating work.

So with demand being so high, our new production facilties could hardly have come at a better time. They will increase our production capacity by 30% and cut energy consumption by up to 40%.

"This major investment in new equipment highlights the Kingspan Group's commitment to our Hull manufacturing site. It will enable Kingspan to offer a fast response to our customers, which is so important when we are operating in the global market





where speed of delivery is essential," said Terry Newman, Kingspan Access Floors Managing Director.

"There have been reports in the trade press that some main contractors and developers have concerns that supply of materials will be able to keep up with the expected growth in demand. Our investment in our

production facilities means that from Kingspan's point of view we will be able to meet all requirements."

Press Techniques of Huddersfield custom built the production equipment, which is highly efficient, user friendly, and will provide a major payback on power usage.



International appointment

First Kingspan panels are now available in BIM formats

Kingspan Access Floors has now made its first products available in 3D digital form – as Building Information Modelling (BIM) files.



In the first stage of a commitment to roll out BIM objects across our product range, we have released BIM files for our RMG600 and FDEB38 raised access floor panels, and our Alpha V pedestal.

The objects are registered on the NBS National BIM Library www.nationalbimlibrary.com

- the construction industry's free-to-use resource of objects covering all major building fabric systems – and are also available on our own website, www.kingspanaccessfloors.co.uk

Kingspan Access Floors BIM files were developed by RIBA Enterprises and are available in ArchiCAD, Bentley, IFC, Revit, and Vectorworks file formats to help ensure that the majority of BIM users can access them. They incorporate just enough technical information, such as load capabilities, dimensions and clearances, to show how the systems fit into an overall design without overwhelming the user's systems.

Ian Lomas, one of Kingspan's Specification Sales Managers, said: "We have decided to make our systems available in BIM formats in response to customer feedback and Government expectations for the development of BIM.

"An increasing number of main contractors and specifiers are now requesting BIM compliance, and the format provides contractors and architects with increased versatility of tangible information when working on projects. BIM is here now and it will not be going away. The UK's construction industry is



changing and we at Kingspan Access Floors are embracing this as for the benefit of all involved, now and for the future."

The Government's strategy for the UK construction sector states that BIM will play an increasingly important role in helping the UK to increase its share of a global construction market that is forecast to grow by over 70% by 2025. BIM Level 2 will be mandatory on all Government projects by the end of 2016.

The benefits of BIM files

BIM files enable architects, designers and specifiers to download 3D objects with embedded information and incorporate them into their designs.

They are fully utilised during design, specification, tender, construction and as a 3D library throughout the life and demolition of a building, to record and illustrate all of the building elements used.

BIM involves both an output and the process. The output is a database that represents all elements of the building and structure and the 'properties' of each element.

As a process, BIM is about project participants putting together this digital information so that ultimately, it can be handed over to the client or user to manage performance of the assets in a more efficient and effective manner.

Flooring for Dubai's Ruler

KINGSPAN HAS SUPPLIED 9,800 SQ M OF FLOOR PANELS FOR A BUILDING IN DUBAI THAT WILL ACCOMMODATE THE PRIVATE OFFICE OF THE RULER OF DUBAI AND OFFICES FOR THE USD95 BILLON MERAS DEVELOPMENT.

The Engineers' Office is the private office of His Highness Sheikh Mohammed Bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice President of the UAE and Ruler of Dubai.

The Office is responsible for the design, procurement, construction and maintenance of facilities for the Royal Family in Dubai and the UAE. Typical projects include palaces, private islands, staff accommodation and community projects such as mosques, schools, shops and national housing schemes.

The Meras Development is a redevelopment of Dubai. Its Jumeira Garden City project incorporates offshore islands, unique development concepts and integrated city development in the Al Satwa and Al Safa areas of Dubai.

Kingspan is mainly supplying RG2 floor panels for the office building, in a contract awarded via Al Nabooda Interiors, who are working for the main contractor, Khan Saheb Civil Engineering and Construction.
