Roof tiles: Russell®

Composition and manufacture

Russell® tiles are manufactured to BS EN 490 and BS EN 491:2004 for concrete roofing tiles.

Premium Tile Range:

Moray is a thin leading-edge flat interlocking tile with a riven effect giving the appearance of natural slate.

Argyll is a flat tile with a single roll giving a slight undulation to the roof profile.

Galloway is a thin leading-edge flat interlocking tile with the appearance of slate.

Highland is a traditional flat tile with a mock joint to give the appearance of small slates.

Lothian is a thin leading-edge tile with a mock joint giving the appearance of European plain tiles.

Commercial Tile Range:

Cheviot is a standard profiled tile that has a trapezoid-shaped roll to provide an attractive undulating surface.

Derwent is a standard profiled tile with a bold roll to give an appealing deep undulating appearance.

Derwent II is a thinner, lighter-weight tile with a deep bold roll giving an undulating appearance.

Double Roman is a standard profiled tile with a small round roll.

Grampian is a standard flat interlocking tile.

Pennine is a standard-profile tile with a subtle soft-roll design.

Heritage Plain Tile range:

The Plain Tile has the appearance of a traditional clay tile but the strength and economy of a concrete tile. Available in 10 smooth-finish colours and four Heritage range colours. A two-tone granular option is also available.
