Case Study

Holme Valley Camping & Caravan Park

Holme Valley camping and caravan park is nestling in a valley on the edge of the Peak District.

Facilities recently expanded which involved the construction of a luxury toilet and shower block.

Cubicle Centre offered layout and design advice in the early stages. *Cairngorm* cubicles were chosen to create the modern design the owners were looking for.

The washroom block received a *David Bellamy Special Distinction award* in October 2014.



VisitEngland is the country's national tourist board. Its role is to grow the value of tourism by working in partnership with the industry. They offer guidance on what washroom facilities Holiday, Touring and Camping Parks should provide.

Washroom Facility Basic Requirements



The washroom block must be open at all times when the park is open.



Hot and cold water must be available in all 'in use' showers and toilet blocks at all reasonable times.



Hair drying facilities provided as a minimum in the female washrooms.



The washroom facilities must be adequately lit, internally and externally, during the hours of darkness whilst the park is open.



Adequate heating of the facilities must be provided through winter.



Where multiple washroom blocks or facilities are provided they must be of a comparable standard.



Shower facilities must have sufficient lighting for safe usage at all times.



Baby change facilities should be available in both male and female washrooms.



Disabled access to washroom facilities should be considered.

Here are the minimum provisions that you need to provide in your toilet and shower cubicles as recommended by *VisitEngland*.

The Minimum You Should Provide




Toilet facilities should provide:

- Toilet seat, toilet roll and holder
- Sanitary disposal facility in at least 50% of cubicles (ladies)
- Wash hand basins with plugs & soap
- Hand drying facilities



Shower cubicles should provide:

- Door and / or shower curtain
- Non-slip shower base or non-slip shower mats
- A shelf or soap dish within the shower



Clothes hooks to be fitted:

- Within each WC cubicle
- Inside shower cubicles if there is a dry changing area within or to be fitted immediately adjacent
- Adjacent to and convenient for use with wash basins



How Many Toilet Cubicles & Showers Do You Need?



Where is this information from?

Guidance on the provision of toilets and showers can vary depending on the local council.

Most refer back to the document *Caravan Sites & Control of Development Act 1960*.

This advice, while not necessarily law, should be considered as good practice.

| Sanitary appliance | Male visitors | Female visitors |
|--------------------|---|---|
| WC | 1 WC per 30 pitches | 2 WCs per 30 pitches |
| Urinals | 1 Urinal per 30 pitches | N/A |
| Wash basins | 2 wash basins per 30 units | 2 wash basins per 30 units |
| Showers | 1 per 25 pitches (when over 70 pitches) | 1 per 25 pitches (when over 70 pitches) |


Shower Cubicle Configurations

There are many ways you can provide your visitors with great shower facilities. Here are some common made-to-measure shower cubicle layouts to consider when planning your washroom refurbishment.


- 1 Square shower trays with curtains
- 2 Enclosed shower cubicles with lockable doors
- 3 Shower trays with dry changing area and bench seating



Toilet Cubicle Sizes - Universal Access Guidelines



Toilet Cubicle Sizes - Explained



Enlarged WC Cubicles:

Where there are 4 or more cubicles in a washroom, one of these must be an enlarged cubicle.

Enlarged cubicles must be a minimum width of 1200mm and include an outward opening door.

A horizontal and vertical grab rail set is required around the WC.

Standard Toilet Cubicles:

All standard cubicles must now have a minimum of 450mm diameter manoeuvring space within the cubicle.

Indicator-bolts must be capable of being operated with a closed fist (single action) - and doors must allow for emergency access should the user collapse and become trapped in the cubicle.


Ambulant Disabled Cubicles:

Every same-sex washroom must have at least one wc cubicle that is suitable for the ambulant disabled.

If there is only one cubicle in the washroom this must be suitable for an ambulant disabled person.

The ambulant disabled cubicle must include an outward opening door.

Toilet Cubicle Sizes - Wheelchair Accessible Cubicles




Wheelchair Accessible Cubicles:

The wheelchair accessible layout has been modified to accommodate an overall toilet cubicle length of 2220mm (previously 2000mm).


The door opening needs to be 900mm with a 950mm (wide) outward opening door.


In commercial washrooms, at least one WC cubicle in a range of separate sex WC's should be provided for use by the ambulant disabled.




