
















CHRISTCHURCH HARBOUR HOTEL & SPA DORSET

WARDOUR STREET LONDON




First occupied by Gainsford & Company, a silk mercer, draper and house furnisher from 1819, and later from 1895 to 1910 becoming home to Albion House Clothing Company, the beautiful structure sitting between London Bridge and Borough stations now houses 'St Christopher's at The Village', an award-winning accommodation, and features Mumford & Wood sash windows throughout.

Cheltenham is famous for its regency architecture, and this three-storey shopping centre is in the heart of one of the Cotswold's premier districts. 









