

Need Planning Advice?

Before you order a shelter, walkway or canopy, you will need to find out if planning and/or building regulations approval is required. The best way to find out is to contact your local council. They can advise on whether you need permission and the type of application you'll need to make.

Please note that it can take some local councils up to 3 months to grant a decision.

If planning and/or building regulations approval/permission is not required, contact us to book in your installation — **Call Freephone 0800 1777 052**

If planning and/or building regulations are required, you will need to apply for planning permissions. This can be undertaken by your business or using an external consultant. **NBB Outdoors** are happy to assist you throughout the process by providing relevant drawings, technical information and any further advice you may need.

1. Design

We begin by creating detailed GA drawings. Whether based on site surveys or unique project requirements, our technical drawings are produced, ensuring alignment with customer expectations. The GA drawings are issued to the customer for consultation & sign off, before progressing to production drawings.

3. Steel Bending

Our cold rolling machine, shapes shelters like the Kimmeridge and Lutton, while the Nargesa CC90 tube and pipe bender creates curves for bike racks and scooter racks.



Precision Coating

Our coating and painting processes are tailored to each product. For the TripleX range, a multi-step process including zinc-rich primer and topcoat powder ensures durability and aesthetic appeal. Standard techniques involve zinc-rich priming followed by topcoat application for lasting protection.

2. Precision Cutting

Our production process utilises in-house machinery to ensure precise and efficient steel cutting. For straightforward cuts, we employ a high-performance band saw that

delivers clean, accurate edges. When it comes to intricate designs or complex geometries, our state-of-the-art CNC Tube and Pipe Plasma Cutter steps in, allowing us to execute detailed patterns and shapes with pinpoint accuracy.

4. Surface Preparation

Before painting, surface preparation is key.
We employ shot blasting with techniques remove rust and other imperfections, mill scale, and oil/grease. Additionally, our Phoswashing technique ensures pristine surfaces, allowing powder to adhere for optimal bonding.



The Customer: The corporate entity, firm or individual ordering the goods from the Company. All orders are made on the following terms & conditions alone. Should a third party, contracted by the customer, impose additional requirements, hinder access or progress we reserve the right to pass any resulting costs back to the customer.

The No Butts Bin Company Ltd sales representatives have no authority to make any representation or promise on the company's behalf or to vary these terms & conditions.

Prices: Unless stated to be fixed for a stated period, The No Butts Bin Company Ltd reserves the right to change prices at anytime without prior notice. All prices are excluding VAT. For the purpose of quotations, prices are based on a number of assumptions and should these assumptions not be correct, we reserve the right to amend the quoted pricing accordingly.

Credit: The Company will agree to issue the Customer with credit subject to status. The Company will conduct one or more credit searches on the Customer during the quotation and order process in order to establish an acceptable level of Credit. Results of these searches will be retained by the Company, but will not be shared with any outside party.

Deposit: Subject to the results of the credit check(s), the value of the order, and the bespoke nature of any shelter\walkway being provided the Company may request a deposit payment to be made at the point of placing the order.

Payment: The customer will agree to pay the full invoice amount less any deposit already paid within 30 days from the date of invoice unless otherwise agreed in writing.

Risk & Title: The risk of the Goods passes to the Customer at the point of delivery, or upon completion of Installation. The Customer shall hold the goods in a fiduciary capacity until such time as full payment has been received. Title and full ownership of the goods will only pass to the Customer on receipt by the Company of all monies due under the order.

Installation: If you request us to install your shelter(s), our installation team will require unhindered access to the site area once arrived on site, all No Butts Bin Company staff are aware that an induction may take place prior to work commencing however should this delay the start of the installation we reserve the right to charge for this time accordingly. As mentioned at your site survey we take all fixing points at face value, should we discover once excavation has started that areas are unsuitable or extra work is required, we reserve the right to charge for any additional work. In the unlikely event that further work is required we will inform you prior to work commencing.

The company considers unhindered access would allow the unloading of any delivery vehicles, parking of fitters vans and positioning of skips could take place between the hours of 08:00 and 17:00 and would be within 10 meters of the installation footprint. To ensure the integrity of the customer's site, access/egress routes will be agreed in advance as NBB cannot take responsibility for pre-existing ground conditions including roadways and footways.

Returns: The Company will supply the customer with products on the condition that the customer will test them in actual use and will have determined whether the products are suitable for particular use to which they are to be applied. In the event of the product not meeting the customer's requirements, it must be returned to the Company in a re-saleable condition within 30 days of delivery. Depending on the circumstances, a delivery charge and\or re-stocking fee may apply. Please note, if you wish to return the shelter or part thereof you purchased after the 30 day period then a restocking fee / delivery charge will be applicable. If the shelter was installed by our installation team, you may still be liable for the cost of installation and any associated groundworks.

Damaged & Missing Products: The Customer must make any claims for damaged or missing product within 7 working days of receipt of delivery. The Company reserves the right to refuse any claims made after 7 working days. This does not affect the Customer's statutory rights.

In such circumstances, we will either make good any shortage or non-delivery; replace or repair any goods that are damaged or defective upon delivery; or refund to you the amount paid by you for the goods in question. Any credits and refunds will be made only after the Company's receipt and inspection of the goods. Refunds will only be provided using the same payment card used to place the order.
