

## Maintenance bill slashed



Residents of a luxury block of flats in Hythe, Kent, have made huge savings on their maintenance charges thanks to Celuform.

The cost of repainting the old timber fascia and soffit at Hume Court was £12,000 every three years. The new low-maintenance PVC-ue replacements have eliminated this at a stroke.

Celuform's Conquest 19mm square fascia with unvented soffit and Elite 25mm sub-fascia fixed direct to the brickwork below the soffit were chosen for the 350 metre perimeter of the flats.

The installation was carried out by C&S Roofing of St Mary's Bay, Kent. Colin Jones, the company's joint owner, said: "Installing the Conquest fascia and soffit was simple.

When it came to installing the Elite sub fascia though, we found it a bit more challenging. Half of the building had wood noggins for us to fix the board but on some areas the sub fascia could only be fixed directly to the brickwork." Steve and Colin like using Celuform PVC-ue materials.
