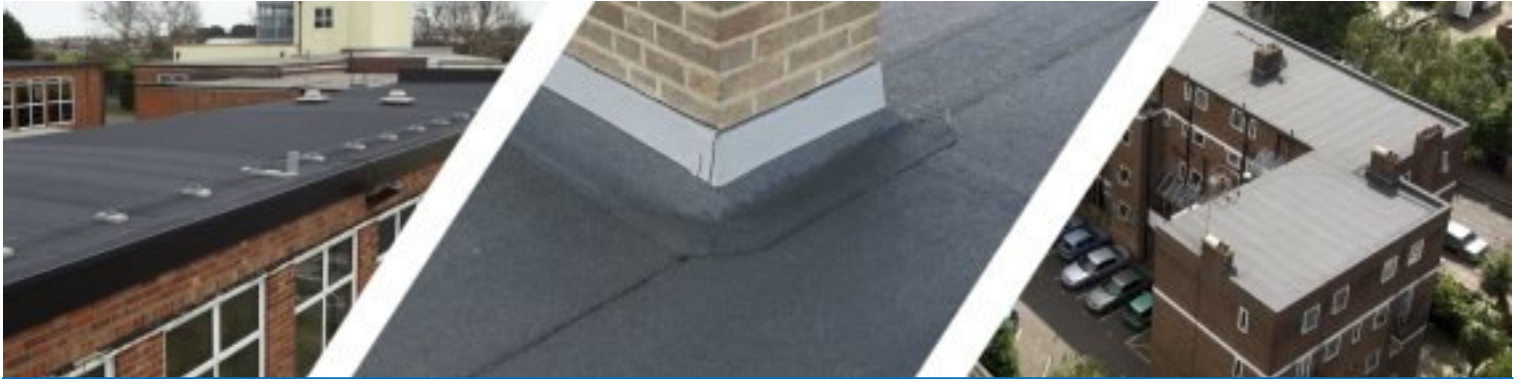

PERFORATED UNDERLAY FOR PARTIALLY-BONDED BUILT-UP BITUMINOUS ROOF WATERPROOFING SYSTEMS

DESCRIPTION

Veralvent is a perforated bituminous underlay for the controlled partial bonding of built-up roof waterproofing systems that are bonded with hot bitumen.

USE

Veralvent is for use as the first layer in built-up roof waterproofing systems where a partial bond to the substrate is required. Such substrates include concrete, woodwool and plywood roof decks and rigid urethane and phenolic foam insulation boards. **Veralvent** should not be used on slopes of more than 10° from the horizontal.

COMPOSITION

Reinforcement:	80 g/m ² perforated glass fibre mat
Bitumen:	oxidised bitumen
Surface:	sand
Underside:	slate flakes

NOMINAL DIMENSIONS AND WEIGHTS

Thickness:	2.6 mm
Rolls:	20 m x 1 m
Weight:	42.6 kg/roll
Diameter of perforations:	40 mm
Proportion of perforations:	120 No./m ² (15%)

APPLICATION

Veralvent is laid loose with 50 mm laps and is then secured through the perforations as the next layer is fully bonded with hot bitumen bonding compound. For a margin of 500 mm at perimeters and around openings, **Veralvent** should be either omitted or fully bonded.
